The season begins after the end of school (June 24) and continues until the end of July (*for selected swimmers, will extend through the first week of August*). The swim team is open to swimmers ages 5-17 who are members of the Leonia Swim Club.

Leonia is part of the Bergen Six competitive league. Thus, participation in the swim team will include daily morning practice **and** swim meets.

REQUIREMENTS

All swimmers ages 5 to 17 must be members of the Leonia Swim Club to register.

(The Leonia Swim Club offers a discounted membership for Leonia High School Students – Contact the Recreation Center for details)

Swimmers must know how to swim independently from one end of the pool to another in **12 feet** of water. There will be no exceptions. We will not be running any try-out sessions, everyone that signs up will automatically be on the team. **BUT** if coaches see that a child is not ready, the swimmer will be unable to join our team. We must enforce this rule for your child's safety. Swim team is NOT swimming lessons.

AGE GROUPS and SWIMMING ABILITY REQUIREMENTS

5/6	Must be able to swim independently across the shallow end of the pool.
7/8	Must be able to swim 25 meters freestyle competently
9/10	Must be able to dive off the block & competently swim 25 meters freestyle and 25 meters of one other competitive stroke. (breast, back, butterfly)
11/17	Must be able to dive off the block & competently swim 50 meters freestyle and 50 meters of one other competitive stroke.

MEMBERSHIP FEES

\$100 for one swimmer. (Unfortunately, due to a price increase from our insurance company fees had to be raised)

Family plan: \$100 for the first child, \$70 for the second, and \$60 for third and up.

MEET SCHEDULE

<u>Plan ahead for one Wednesday evening meet and one Saturday morning meet for all</u> <u>the weeks of July</u>. We cannot predict the duration of each meet but plan on 3-4 hours. Your time commitment is crucial to the success of the season and it is important that you inform your coaches well in advance of travel plans.

UNIFORMS/SPIRITWEAR

Uniforms - Our original swimsuits have been discontinued. A new brand will be available to purchase June 5th during sign up & June 6th in the evening (time TBD) at the Leonia Swim Club.

Caps will be available to purchase throughout the whole season.

Spirit Wear - can be purchased June 5th during sign up, June 6th in the evening (time TBD) & June 11th during parents meeting at the Leonia Swim Club.

Swim gear (Bags, Towels, Parkas, Goggles & any non team summer swim item) will be available All Year Round online.

WHAT TO EXPECT AT PARENT MEETING

On June 11th, the day of our first practice, there will be a mandatory meeting for parents. We will discuss important information about the upcoming season and will be available to answer questions. Learn more about becoming a parent volunteer, and how you can help our swimmers have an amazing season!

As in past years, the swim team leans on your involvement to ensure a safe, successful season. To equally share the duties and responsibilities of running and participating in the swim meets, we rely on each family to contribute time to one of the necessary tasks. Information on how you can volunteer and help support the team will be discussed at the Parent Meeting.

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

Please consider volunteering to help with Snack Bar, Timers, Runners, and ScoreKeepers. It takes a village to run Swim Team and we cannot do it without you! We will post volunteer sign up sheets on our website at www.leoniaswimteam.com

POLICIES

*Every swimmer must attend at least one practice during the week to be eligible to compete in the Swim Meets.

*Coaches will determine which event(s) a child enters during Swim Meets primarily based on, but not limited to, their recorded times. Coaches will also take into account overall team strength in certain strokes; number of events a swimmer can participate in; and the need to have swimmers available for relay teams, among other considerations.

*Parents should not discuss nor try to influence the decisions of the coaches as to who swims what events at the Swim Meets.

*Ribbons will be awarded to all "heat 1" winners. Participant ribbons will be given for all other heat swimmers.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF SWIM TEAM PARENTS

*One Parent of children ages 5 – 9 must be at the pool during practice. If you are unable to do so, please arrange for another adult, <u>not another swim team member or coach</u>, to look after your child.

*Parents are responsible for transporting swimmers to and from Swim Meets. Directions to all pools that we will visit will be posted on our website and included in a reminder email the night before..

*Parents will be asked to donate baked goods, fruit, and healthy snacks to be sold at our Snack Bar during home meets. This is one of our biggest fundraisers each year, and the proceeds go right back to our children, and help pay league fees and our coaches. Volunteers are always needed at the Snack Bar, feel free during a meet to walk over and offer to help out.

*To eliminate confusion, and to give our coaches the space that they need so that they can concentrate, parents are **not permitted** on the deck (area by the diving blocks) or in the swimmer's waiting area during all Swim Meets. Please make sure your child knows that they must stay in their assigned areas so that they do not miss their turn to compete. If a coach cannot find your child at their assigned time to swim, they will be eliminated from the event. It is not the coaches' job to run around the swim club looking for individual swimmers.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF TEAM SWIMMERS

*Swimmers are to come to practices and Swim Meets on time.

*Bring sweatshirts, sweatpants, and towels to practices and meets. Please have your name on everything to prevent loss or mix up.

*Notify coaches, **at least 2 days before a meet** if your child will not be attending. Please provide vacation dates to your coaches. Not showing up for a scheduled meet could disqualify you from participating in the next meet. It takes a lot of work and planning to set up the meet line up. Last minute changes and no shows, cause additional work on the coaches and meet coordinator. It also takes a spot away from a swimmer that could have swam that event.

*During a meet, you <u>must</u> stay in the designated area for Leonia swimmers. Each swimmer is responsible to be prepared for his/her event at Swim Meets.

***TEAM SPIRIT-** all swimmers should support fellow teammates and remain at a meet until the end. We need to show our competitors that we have the best team spirit in the league. GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP!
